“Public and private support of the arts and culture”

This international master class, organized by the Doctoral school of Human Sciences and CEMESO (Centre for the Studies on Media and Culture) at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel, addresses the research on public & private support of the arts/ culture in a variety of academic disciplines. PhD students are invited to present their research concerning public and private support of the arts and culture in a broad sense, including contemporary and historical research about arts & artistic policy, public and private support of the arts and research about broadcasting institutions. The presenters will receive feedback on their work from experts representing different scientific disciplines.

A keynote lecture will be held by Dr. Volker Kirchberg, since 2004 professor at the department “organization and distribution of the arts” of the faculty of cultural science at the university of Lüneburg (Germany). His publications deal with the sociology of culture, urban sociology, intersections in the market, the state and the non-profit sector.

Format: abstracts and papers/posters

We welcome PhD researchers to present work on public and private support in the themes: contemporary and historical research about arts & artistic policy, public and private support of the arts and research about broadcasting institutions. We are aiming for an interdisciplinary master class with posters and oral paper presentations. The format for the oral presentations will be a 10 minute paper presentation followed by 5 minutes of feedback by the expert and 5 minutes for questions and discussion. The language of communication will be English.

Interested PhD students are expected to submit a short curriculum of approximately 100 words (including author’s name, affiliation, address, phone number and e-mail) and an abstract in English of approximately 300 words in electronic form (Font: Verdana, 9 pt, line spacing 1,5) to: ldecang@vub.ac.be by **30/10/2009, 12 a.m.** mentioning as **subject ‘seminar DSh16’** and the chosen **format:** poster or oral presentation.

A maximum of 30 applicants will be notified by **27/11/2009** and invited to submit a paper of approximately 5000 words (Font: Verdana, 9 pt, line spacing 1,5) by **08/02/2010**. Members of the

doctoral school can receive 1 credit for active participation, one additional credit for a paper presentation with the paper submitted beforehand.
