## Second year (BA2)

Starting from academic year 2024-2025 the compulsory BA2 course 'Media, Culture and Diversity' will undergo a title change to 'Popular Media Culture and Diversity'. The course content will remain unchanged; therefore this title change will have no impact on your study path. If you have not passed 'Media, Culture and Diversity', you will be taking the course with the new title 'Popular Media Culture and Diversity' as of academic year 2024-2025.

## Third year (BA3): Communication studies

Starting from the academic year 2024-2025, the compulsory first semester course 'Media Psychology and Sociology' in the Communication Studies orientation will be substituted with a new second semester course titled 'Digital Media Sociology'.

- 1. Students who are <u>currently enrolled</u> in 'Media Psychology and Sociology' for the academic year 2023-2024 and <u>do not successfully complete</u> the course will be required to take the new course in the following academic year.
- 2. Students who are <u>currently enrolled</u> in 'Media Psychology and Sociology' for the academic year 2023-2024 and <u>do successfully complete</u> the course will not experience any adjustments.
- 3. Students who are <u>not yet enrolled</u> in 'Media Psychology and Sociology' will be required to take the new course in the following academic year.
